- 3. Window
- 4. Tracing paper
- 5. Transfer paper
- 6. Ruler
- 7. Scrap of paper with marks on it
- 8. Pencil and thumb
- 9. Hand and fingers
- 10. Extension lines from original
- 11. Compass or Callipers
- 1. Photo copier only copy the photo not create a sketch.


